# IMPORTANT MESSAGE ABOUT SUMMER CAMP AT GORHAM SCOUT RANCH IN 2026 AND 2027

The Council's Executive Board has determined that High Desert Council will not be offering a summer camp program for Troops at Gorham Scout Ranch in 2026. Gorham will remain open for all other activities and events, and summer camp will return there in 2027.

Gorham will remain in full operation as a camp facility through 2026 and into 2027 for all other camping, training, Order of the Arrow, Camporee/Klondike, Wood Badge, unit programming, and other activities throughout the year, focused on programs which are volunteer-run. The Camp Ranger at Gorham is being retained to continue to safeguard and maintain Council property.

And we are inviting all HDC troops to join us for a homecoming week to celebrate the 50th Anniversary of the naming of Camp Frank Rand. Details will be out in 2026, but please plan on spending your 2027 summer camp in a revitalized Gorham Scout Ranch!










# In the News



Scroll down to see list of positions and training status for each position:





Participants must be between age 14-17 at the start of the Jamboree on July 30, 2027. Anyone older than that can apply to be a unit leader or on staff.
