Starting Holy Thursday, the K of C Council at Prince of Peace Church will set up their Way Station on NM Hwy 503. The way station will run from Noon Holy Thursday to Noon Good Friday. The Scouts of the Archdiocese of Santa Fe are invited to come and pass out small Crucifixes to the Pilgrims traveling to Chimayo. It is always cold that time of year so dress in layers, wear your Scout uniform, wear a hat, and bring your unit flag. Bring your own water and snacks. There are porta-potties on site. This will be a Scout function, so YPT and the two deep leadership rules apply. There are reflective vests to wear during the hours of darkness. Please Email me, johncsnider@msn.com, as to what times you would like your unit to work. We will pass out Crucifixes from 1 PM Thursday (2 April) until 10 AM Good Friday (3 April). A shift can be one hour to as long as you want. If we run out of Crucifixes, the Scouts can still encourage the Pilgrims on their Journey. Troop 410 will do the Midnight to 6 AM shift.
